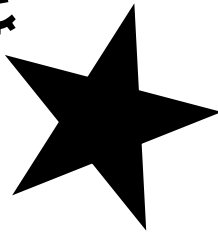


A Universe of Stories

Rules:

1. Bookmarks should fit the theme “**A Universe of Stories**” (Our 2019 Summer Reading Theme) or be about reading, books, or libraries.
2. Your design must fit inside the box. Use colored markers or colored pencils. (Unfortunately, crayons don't work well when we send the designs to be printed.)
3. This contest is for grades K through 12.
4. Your design must be your own, original work. Preference may be given to designs which *do not* feature copyrighted characters (Garfield, Dog Man, etc.)
5. Entries must be turned in to the Youth Services Desk at the Springfield Public Library, 225 Fifth Street, by 6:00pm on Wednesday, October 31, 2018.

Entries will be displayed at the library in binders after the contest. Some designs may also be displayed on posters and walls, as space allows. Come and see all the beautiful artwork!

Each winning bookmark will be printed professionally and used at the library all year. Winners will be presented to the Springfield Mayor and City Council, receive a poster-sized version of their bookmark, and a stack of their bookmarks to share.

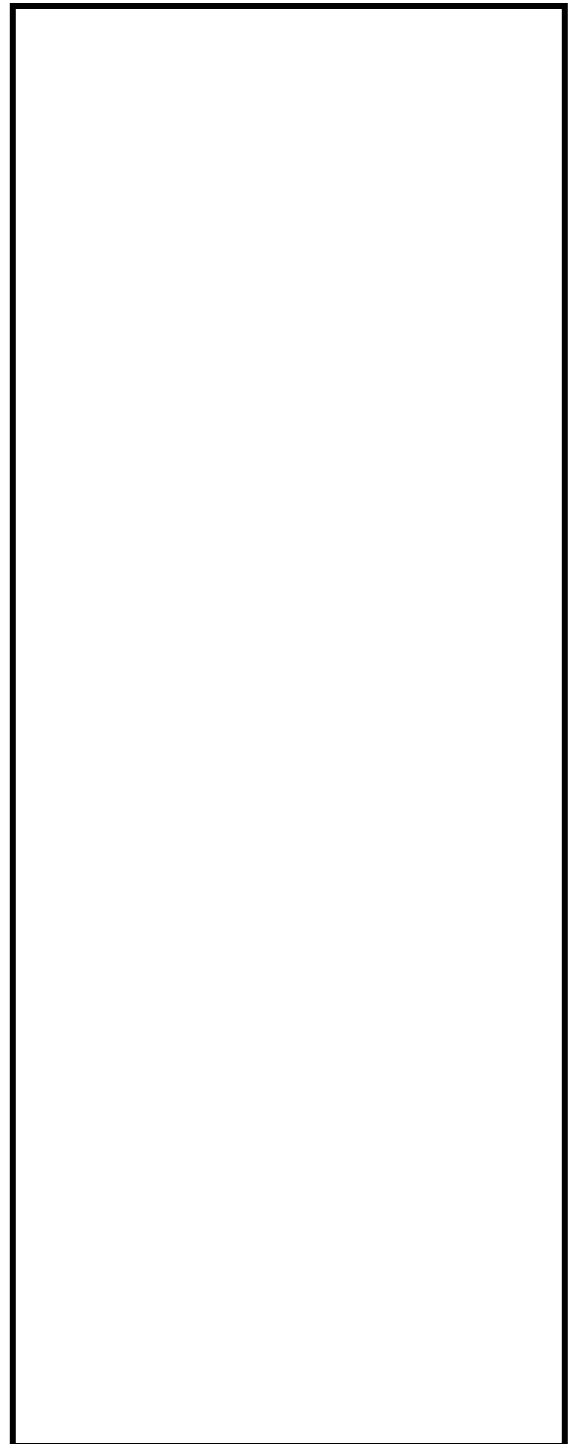
